The primary goal of Dr. Li's research is to develop, evaluate, and disseminate efficient methods for comparing healthcare interventions and to provide trust-worthy evidence for decision-making.

Dr Li has worked with Cochrane in various capacities for 15 years. She served as the Associate Director for Cochrane United States from 2012 to the Center's closure in 2018. Currently, in addition to

her new role as a Coordinating Editor for Cochrane Eyes and Vision, she co-convenes the Cochrane Comparing Multiple Interventions Methods Group. She is an Associate Scientific Editor for the upcoming 2nd edition of the Cochrane Handbook for Systematic Reviews of Interventions.

Outside of Cochrane, Dr Li serves as an Editor-in-Chief for the journal Trials and the Review Editor for JAMA Ophthalmology. She is an elected member of the Society for Research Synthesis Methodology and was awarded the Society's inaugural Early Career Award in 2016.
